Outline of the Event

Number of children: Each school can enter a mixed team of no more than 10 players and each child attending should play for approximately the same amount of time.

Substitutions: Players can be substituted at any time during a game and as many times as required.

Mixed teams: At all times during play there must be at least two girls and two boys on the field of play in each competing team of seven players.

Team Kit: If there is a clash of team kits bibs will be provided.

Shin Pads: All players must wear shin pads. Football boots or trainers may be worn.

Matches: Games will be played in accordance with Football Association rules for the small-sided game. The exact format of the competition will be dependant on the number of teams entered and will be explained to teachers/managers on arrival.
